

Local Leagues

There are two divisions in Little League, Major League and Minor League. Major League is where the eligible tournament players will be selected from and should be a higher standard. Minor League is a development league and should be made up of most 10 year olds.

All 12 year old players must be entered into a Major League team unless exemption has been requested from the District Administrator, upon safety grounds. Each League will be limited to a maximum of 10 Major League teams, with no limit on Minor League. A minimum of 4 Major League teams will be required to create a league and it cannot be within an existing Leagues boundary.

All League boundaries must be marked on a league boundary map prior to each season. These boundaries will be created by each League in consultation with the District Administrator. This map must be lodged with the District Administrator and then forwarded to the National Administrator. The DA will handle all League Boundary enquiries.

Each league will be governed by a League committee which will consist of a League President, Secretary, Treasurer and Coaching Co-ordinator. Most areas around the country will probably already have a similar set up in existence.
