





CLUB & CHARTER INFORMATION

TRANSFERING TO ANOTHER CLUB For players League Age 10 – League Age 16

Club Registrars are to advise Parents that the player is ineligible for State Championships All Star teams if the player transfers to a club outside of their current charter Area where the player resides or goes to school.

State Championships Little League Division 2 and Machine Pitch teams are *not* All-Star Teams.

MANDATORY PROCEDURE FOR CLUB CLEARANCES

Parents must fill in the Charter Acknowledgement form when applying for a club transfer notifying them of the charter exclusion policy when moving out of their charter boundary *prior to Baseball WA approving the transfer*.

The Charter Acknowledgement Form <u>LINK</u> which can also be found on the BWA website under the main menu Competitions | Competition forms. This form is for players who transfer to a club outside of their chartered residential area.

A player will be deemed to reside/stay within the Charter boundary and therefore does not need to complete the form if:

- 1. The player is requesting clearance to another club in the same charter.
- 2. Moves to a club where their residential/registered address is inside that Charter Boundary, and/or;
- 3. The player attends school within the charter's boundary (if selected in an All-Star team the player will need to provide a certificate of enrolment to evidence school attendance https://www.littleleague.org/downloads/school-enrollment-form/)

NOTE: IF such players do not fall into the points stated above, they shall then be deemed to be "redshirted" and cannot play in any Tournament All Star team for 12 months — this is an LL International requirement and cannot be waived. They cannot apply for a Charter clearance.
